## **WATER/SEWER DEPARTMENT**

The starter and probes at the pump house was repaired, and this has eliminated nuisance calls. Restrictor valve repaired.

Updated a new water line installed at a resident's cost to fix a water usage issue.

## **BUILDINGS/VILLAGE PROPERTIES/EQUIPMENT**

Lights had to be replaced in the Village Hall garage after a smoky failure. Electrical work was completed out at the pump house after mouse damage to wiring was discovered.

## **VILLAGE PARK**

Matt Fights addressed need for repair of existing dock estimated at less than \$1000; He will work with Larry to accomplish and anchor the dock over to the boat ramp side in time.

VB interested to hear plans on reclamation, monitoring, bond release, etc. Production for I.D. Badges for use in emergency situations where I.D. is needed were reviewed. Badges and lanyards will be ordered.


