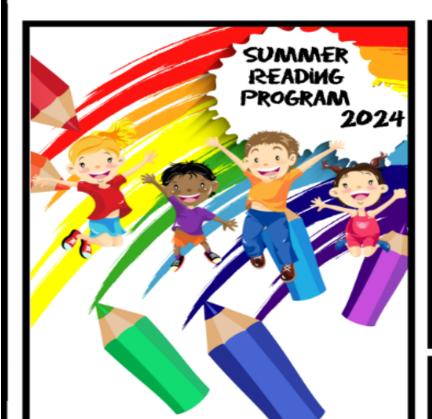
p.s. We expect to complete this in 1 day; If we need more, or a RAIN date, that will be Thursday-Friday June 20 or 21.
